It is accepted that there are possible health risks that may include bleeding or swelling of the brain.

How many people might feel pressured by friends and family into undergoing this treatment if it were available on the NHS?

Who will quantify and explain the risks and weigh them against the benefits?

IMHO NICE has acted very responsibly in their decision on this matter.

I am not sure I agree with the decision of the MHRA.

I have seen no mention of the ethical implications that may arise from this.

Perhaps I am mistaken.

If so, perhaps someone can enlighten me.


